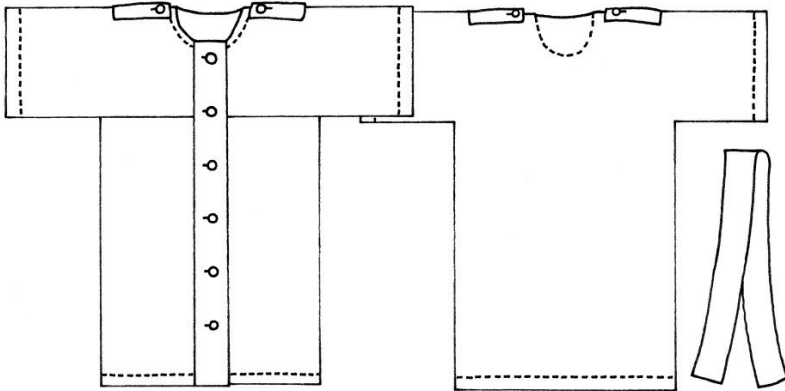


# Zero waste dress

This versatile dress can be made any size. The finished length is approximately 99cm.

## **You'll need to bring**

- ✂ Fabric. Suitable fabrics include denim, firm cotton drill or taffeta. Choose firm, semi-stiff fabrics. Stripes are fine and will run horizontally with the front band running vertically. Unsuitable for checks.
- 150cm wide or wider. To calculate the amount needed, measure around your hips/seat and add 40cm. If you don't require a belt, subtract 12cm.
- ✂ Thread to match.
- ✂ Suitable machine needles
- ✂ Interfacing, 2 strips 12cm wide and approximately 92cm long for the front bands
- ✂ 9 x 23mm buttons for the front and epaulettes.
- ✂ 12mm bias binding, approximately 40cm, for the neck.
- ✂ Sewing machine and sewing kit.
- ✂ Your lunch.
