
## A-Line Skirt in a Day

Make yourself an A-line skirt with a back zip, faced waist and with or without pockets.



## You'll need to bring

- ✗ Fabric. Suitable fabrics are corduroy, medium weight denim, wool, drill or cotton. How much?
  - 115cm wide fabric (one or two-way): 140cm (ie twice the length)

150cm wide fabric (one-way): 140cm (ie twice the length)

150cm wide fabric (two-way): 1m

The skirt is 60cm long finished; bring extra fabric for a longer skirt.

- X Zip. Either a 20cm regular (dress) zip or a 25cm invisible zip. Remember to bring the correct foot for your machine.
- $\lambda$  Thread to match.
- $\bigstar$  Interfacing, 25cm, suitable for the weight of your fabric.
- $\bigstar$  6mm cotton tape for the waist (it comes in black or white; Clare Fashion and Fabrics sells it).
- $\bigstar$  Sewing machine and sewing kit.

## You'll also need

- $\bigstar$  Pattern paper (eg a roll of greaseproof paper) for your pattern.
- $\bigstar$  Pen and paper if you want to take notes.
